



# IVAO Tunisia Division

## Regulations for Virtual Airline (VA) Registration

### Article 1: General Requirements

- All Virtual Airlines (VAs) seeking to operate under the IVAO Tunisia Division must be officially certified by IVAO Headquarters.
- To be registered, any VA must comply with the specific requirements set forth by the IVAO Tunisia Division in this document.

### Article 2: Operational Requirements

#### operational Requirements

- The VA must establish and maintain at least one operational hub in an airport located in Tunisia.
- All VA activities and flights must be conducted from or to Tunisian airports.
- A VA will be considered inactive if there are no flights logged by its members for a continuous period of one (1) month. Inactivity will result in the automatic suspension of the VA's registration.
- VAs are required to participate in official IVAO Tunisia Division events when needed.

### Article 3: Website Requirements

- Each VA must always operate and maintain a fully functional and publicly accessible website.
- The website must feature an up-to-date pilot roster and a staff list. These pages must be accessible to the public without requiring user registration or login.
- The website must be written in English and fully functional.

#### Notes:

- All registration requests must be formally submitted to the IVAO Tunisia Flight Operations Department.
- Each request will be carefully reviewed to ensure full compliance with the requirements mentioned above.
- Once the registration is approved, the VA:
  1. Will be provided a coordination channel on the division's Discord.
  2. Must include the Tunisia division's logo on the VA's website homepage and provide a link to the division's website.
